# Discussion 1: Fr (Prof) George Thadathil, Chairperson (IQAC), Principal/Rector

- The opening note was delivered by Fr (Prof) George Thadathil, Chairperson (IQAC), Principal / Rector of Salesian College thanking:
  - IQAC organizers (Dr Terence Mukhia IQAC Co-ordinator, Salesian College, Dr SC Das IQAC Co-ordinator (Siliguri), Mr Dhiren Newar IQAC Secretary (Sonada), Mr Subhajit Bose IQAC Secretary (Siliguri), Mr Subhajit Paul IQAC Secretary (Siliguri).
  - o External Members: Dr Minakshi Chakraborty Principal, KGTM (Expert from Educational field) & Mr Eugene Gurung Entrepreneur (Employers/Industrialists/Stakeholders).
  - o Rector Fr. (Dr) Tomy Augustine Rector (Salesian College Sonada), Vice Principals, Deans and all the prominent members with higher education ministry role in Salesian College.
- The Second part of the opening note was the purpose of this IQAC meeting to evaluate our performance and activities and also set certain targets and guidelines for our upcoming months in order to plan, motivate and play our individual roles as best as we can.

# • **Topic**: New Faculty Recruitment to fill up the Vacant Position:

- o The interview of new faculty has been completed from 21st June to 26th June 2021.
- o There were altogether 100+ applicants for the vacant post.
- o Except for final confirmation with regard to 2 positions both in Sonada & Siliguri campus, all the others as per the requirements have been completed.
- o The list of selected candidates will be circulated to the Deans &Vice Principals soon after the official formalities are completed.

### • **Topic**: Induction Programme for the New Faculty Members joining this Year:

- o The Newly recruited Faculty members will join the College only when the situation normalizes.
- o Since the Examination are yet to complete, Correction of the Answer scripts are to be done and also the New Admission are yet to happen, so the Induction Programme of the Newly joined faculty will likely to happen in the 1<sup>st</sup> week of September 2021.

## • Topic: Objective of organizing the Webinar on "Blended Mode" on 6th & 7th August 2021:

- o To understand the document of UGC in regard to the process of blended mode as per their expectation of teaching and learning of future.
- o To offer some critic.
- o To know what are the technicalities of Blended mode of teaching and learning.
- o Indented to invite different speakers from different colleges to share their experiences and stories to understand better and share that knowledge.

## • Topic: Major Benchmark for the Academic Year 2020 - 2021:

- 1) Firstly, Introduction of the **Academic Audit** this year for all the faculty members, where the HoDs of respective departments presented on behalf of his or her team members of their department to the expert from Santiniketan University, Dr. Dr SC Das and Fr. Principal. The Academic Audit report of each faculty was then evaluated by the College Management for Finance Policy as per their performance.
- 2) Secondly, the Benchmark for this year is in regard to the **Annual Report 2020-2021** of B.Voc department of Sonada Campus which has been prepared by Mr. Dhiren Newar has been circulated to all the Vice Principals and Deans of both Sonada Campus and Siliguri Campus as a Model to be followed by all the HoDs to prepare their departmental Annual Reports going forward.
- 3) Thirdly, the Benchmark for this year is in regard to **Meeting Circular and Notices** that was prepared Mr. Peter Lepcha.

# Discussion 4: Mr Subhajit Paul, IQAC Secretary (Siliguri)

- Mr. Subhajit Paul, the IQAC Secretary of Siliguri Campus made the next Power point (PPT) presentation and the following highlights were explained in the IQAC meeting for the day.
- o Co curricular Events & Activities organized for the even semester (Jan June 2021).
- o Internal Examination conducted for the even semester (Jan June 2021).
- o Total Webinar organized for the even semester (Jan June 2021).
- o IQAC Initiatives, Contribution & Outcomes for the even semester (Jan June 2021).
- o IQAC Future Plan for coming (Odd) Semester (July December 2021).
- **Topic**: Blended mode of teaching & learning for same section students in both offline & online mode:
- o One section of the students coming to college for the offline classes, the faculty recorded the live video of the classes taken and was circulated to the students of other section who could not attend the offline mode of classes. This way helped all the students of the same class cover they syllabus.

## Discussion 5: Dr Minakshi Chakraborty, Entrepreneur (Employers/Industrialists/Stakeholders)

## • **Topic**: Information on resuming of Normal Offline Regular Classes:

- o No, information as such. Waiting for 15<sup>th</sup> July for the Official notification probably to be released by the West Bengal Government.
- Would like to know how Salesian College is imparting the Blended mode of Teaching & Learning?

#### Observations:

- o Dr. Minakshi Chakraborty appreciated how well that the series of Events & Activities organized and conducted was maintained by Salesian College and separation between Departments and IQAC.
- o How would Salesian College conduct the blended mode of teaching and learning where some section of students are attending the same classes from home and the other section of the students are attending the offline physical classes at the same time?
- o Dr. Minakshi Chakraborty highlighted her issues in regard to:
  - ✓ The poor internet and network connectivity due to which the students cannot even upload the **pdf** and instead the students provided in image format which make the faculty members very difficult to evaluate those assignments.
  - ✓ Most of the students not able to afford smart phones.
  - ✓ Very difficult to take the online classes where there are huge numbers of students in a particular course especially in the General Courses.
  - ✓ Dr. Minakshi Chakraborty said that since Salesian College has the potential for excellence and a Grade A college for several years, she would like to seek extensive help and support from the college to address such issues to resolve those problems as highlighted and better their online classes.

# Discussion 6: Mr. Dhirodatta Subba, Dean, Sciences

## • Topic: Information on resuming of Normal Offline Regular Classes:

- o UGC has stated that going forward the nature of teaching & learning to be blended mode in future.
- o The Blended mode would continue to persist till the situation normalizes.
- o Webinar on: 'Blended Mode' to be organized on 6<sup>th</sup> & 7<sup>th</sup> August 2021 and this will also be posted to all the institution of North Bengal & Sikkim region that will help in moving forward for conduction the blended mode to teaching & learning in a systematic and professional manner.

## • Topic: AQAR 2020-2021 & AQAR 2021-2022:

o Mr. Dhirodatta Subba, Dean, Sciences stated that in regard to the AQAR 2020-21 & 2021-22, the members would be getting a training from Mr. Suma Dey as there has been a change in the procedure of documentation of the NAAC. So, Mr. Suman and his team would be visiting Siliguri campus on 19<sup>th</sup> July 2021 to talk about the new process and procedure of preparing the reports for the NAAC.

## Discussion 7: Mr. Patrick Johnson, Dean, Commerce, Management Studies & Vocational Studies

### • Topic: Blended mode of teaching & learning for same section students in both offline & online mode:

- o Each department accordingly has to plan out as per the requirements.
- o The number of hours per lecture was shortened and incorporated more of online activities, assignments, class tests.
- o For Practical Classes, the students were divided into smaller groups of 20 each and the seniors took the responsibilities of sharing what they have learnt. The Seniors then divided the 1<sup>st</sup> students into 5 each and they shared their learning practical experiences and simultaneously also trained them. After a month, a competition was organized.
- o The students exchange programme was also organized between Sonada & Siliguri Campus as a part of blended mode of teaching and learning.
- o Overall the Blended mode of education has involved for the faculties, seniors and as well as the new students simultaneously in the process of teaching and learning.

## Discussion 7: Mr. Peter Lepcha, Dean, Arts/Humanities

- Topic: Action Plan in regard to the NAAC Criteria 7 (Last Paragraph):
- o Based on the action plan to be taken in regard to the NAAC Criteria mentioned in the last paragraph, if that could be done before hand rather than putting it in the last moment would be better.

## Discussion 7: Br. Jose, Vice Principal, Sonada

- Topic: Induction Programme for the New Faculty Members joining this Year:
- o Br. Jose, Vice Principal of Sonada campus stated that the IQAC office would be furnished and fully functional able very soon.
- o Br. Jose, also enquired if the Induction and Training Programme for New Faculty members joining the College can be conducted somewhere in the month of August before they join the college.

## Discussion 8: Dr. Terence Mukhia, IQAC Coordinator, Deans of Arts & Humanities, SCS

- o Dr. Terence Mukhia lighted the points in regard to strengthening the area of research & publication as a part of NAAC Criteria in both the campuses.
- o Dr. Terence Mukhia also suggested motivating our faculty members in publishing articles and journals at least in peer review journals in not in UGC listed Journals.

- Topic: AQAR 2020-2021 & AQAR 2021-2022:
- o Mr. Subhajit Bose, IQAC Secretary of Siliguri campus suggested that if the AQAR 2020 2021 & AQAR 2021 2022 can be done simultaneously so that there is no delay in collating the data later on.
- o Mr. Subhajit Bose suggested if an additional backup of the criterion member can be assigned in case if the actual member for the particular sub criterion in not reachable or absent due to any reason so that it would help in providing of the data from the backup member.




