## Online Examination Report from 6<sup>th</sup> July 2020 to 11<sup>th</sup> July 2020

From 6<sup>th</sup> July 2020 to 11<sup>th</sup> July 2020 Online Examination of both the Campuses had commenced in 6 different time slots as notified in the schedule from the Examination Office. Number of students in each time slots was less than 300 which led to smooth running of the examination without any problem in the dedicated server. There were 34 courses examinations held during the said tenure and time slots as per schedule. 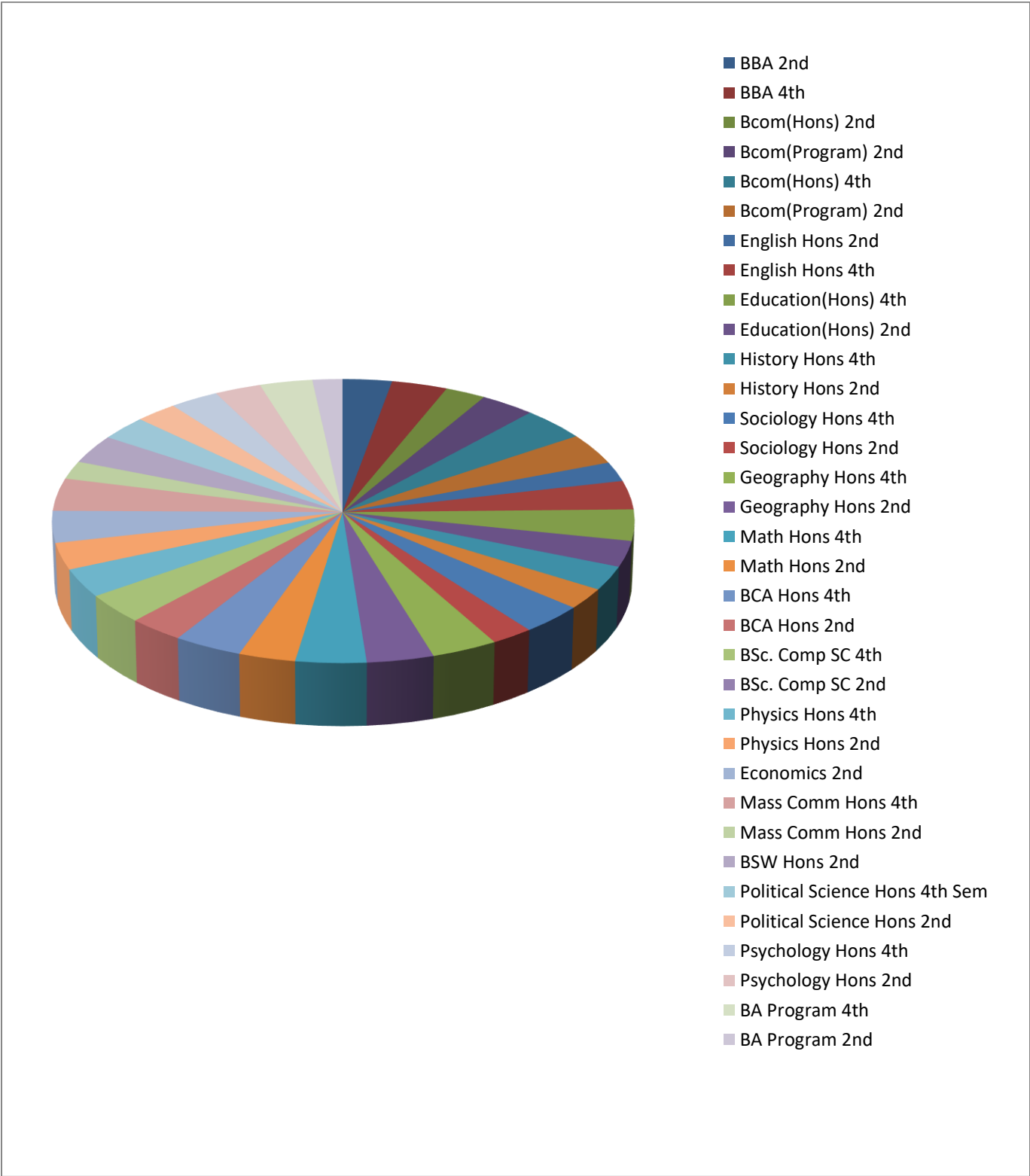


Figure 1 Pie Chart of average % obtained by the students department and semester wise
