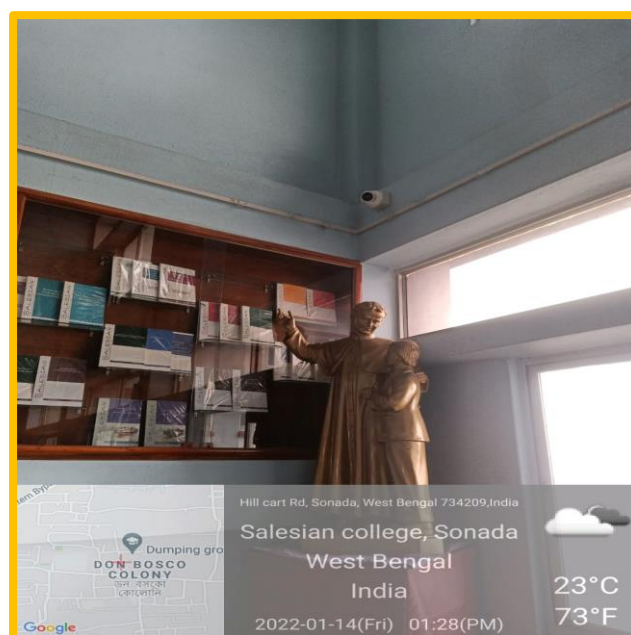
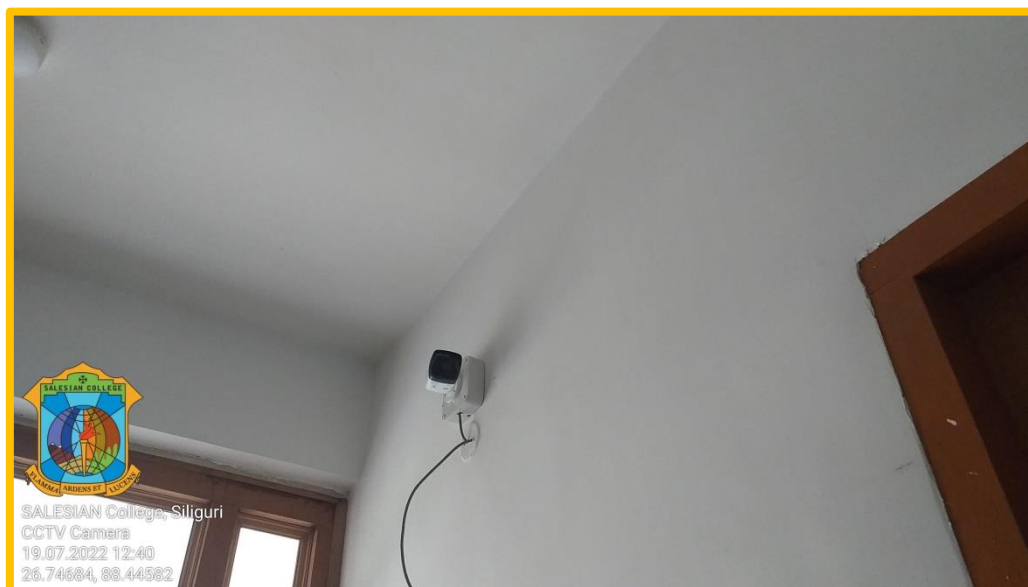

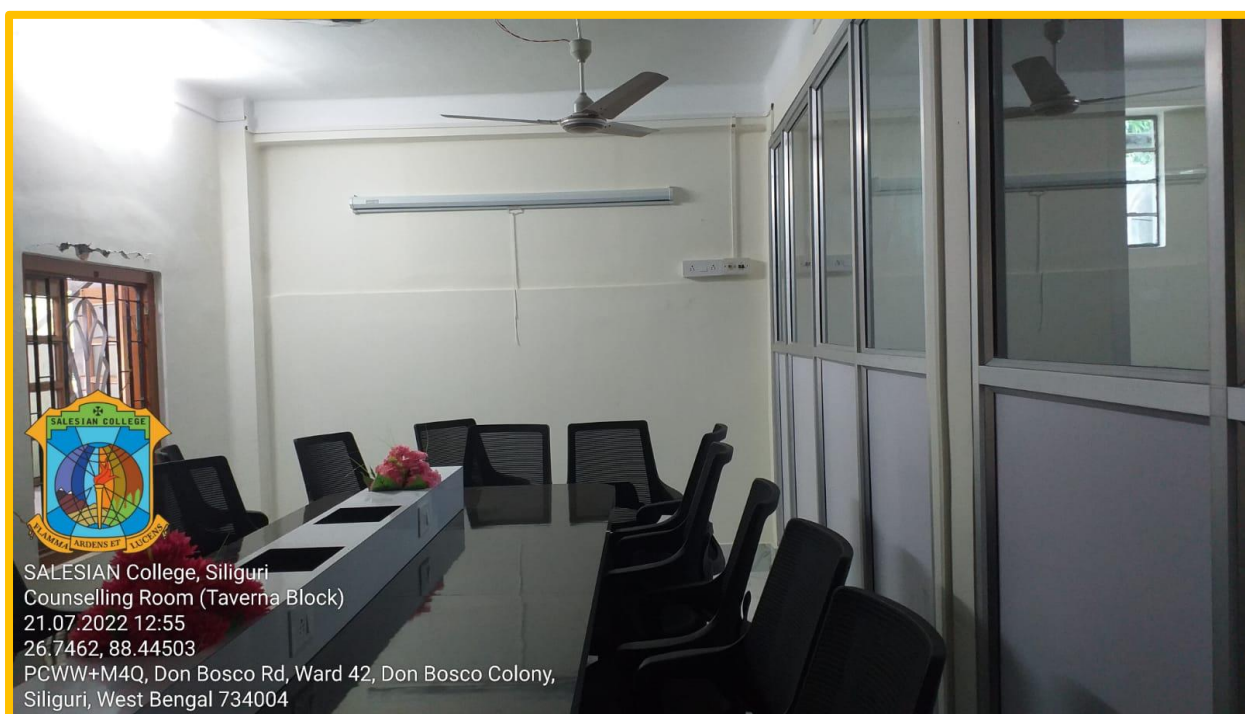




B. Counselling

Gender Sensitivity

On 26 November, 2021 Atrijit Paul and Chetna Dudhani of the Department of Economics were found in an inappropriate and awkward situation of trying to indulge in some proximate physical contact amounting to look/appear like a sexual activity by a support staff of the college in Lecture Hall in the Don Bosco block at 01:40 pm.

The support staff reported Ms. Ganga Parajuli, Coordinator and member of Women Cell that the two students Chetna Dudhani and Atrijit Paul were hugging each other and trying to indulge into sexual activity inside the class room. The class room was empty and only Chetna and Atrijit were present in the class when the incident took place.

On having interviewed separately by Mr. Anirban Ghosh and Ms. Ganga Parajuli, both Chetna and Atrijit accepted that they were hugging each other due to emotional outburst and refused to have indulged in any other sexual behaviour.

The identity cards of both Atrijit and Chetna were confiscated for a week and after having undergone extensive counselling and having apologised for the behaviour it was returned. A written statement of the same from both the students are kept with the Coordinator.

Report on a Gender sensitivity issue

On 23 November 2021, the Women Cell and Grievance Cell received a written complaint from two female students of BBA, Semester I, Salesian College Siliguri. Kriti Tayal and Nidhi Jhavar complained against Suyash Singhal of the same class. In their complaints, the girls mentioned individually about few incidents when they felt that Suyash Singhal did not respect their dignity and touched them inappropriately. They also added that Suyash Singhal has the habit of barging in their private space imperceptively and silently hence looked for an opportunity to physically come in contact with the girls, example being standing right behind them at a close proximity without one's knowledge and as they (girls) turned, their lips were forced to swipe his.

The matter was reported to all the members of Grievance Cell and Women Cell and urgent meeting was called on 24 November 2021. After having the discussions, the committee decided to call Suyash Singhal and interrogate him about the incidents.

In his explanations while with committee members and letter Suyash Singhal accepted that he has touched them and had been in close proximity without meaning any offence and intention. On having explained and taught about the concept of private space by the Faculty of the Grievance and Women cell and he has realised that he should not have entered the private space of the girls and should behave with respect and sensitivity to any person either from the same or the other gender. He also said that he will not repeat such a behaviour again in his future.

Suyash Singhal was asked to stay for an extra hour in the student affairs office for a week as a penalty for hurting the sentiments of his class mates specially Nidhi Jhavar and Kriti Tayal.
